	• Entries must be submitted in YARDS times using Hy-Tek software. Standard 22 events .
	• All entries should have times, and times must have been achieved during a meet and after <u>11/27/17</u> . Time Trials do not count.
	• If you would like to request a lead off relay swim to be observed, please notify the Referee before the start of the meet.
	A Team Manager report of entries must be included along with your entries.
	• Swimmers may enter a maximum of 2 individual events and 2 relay events OR 1 individual event and 3 relay events.
	• Each School may enter 2 swimmers per individual event and 1 relay team per relay event.
	• Exception: Individuals that have already met the state qualifying time may be entered in addition to your two regular entries with a maximum of 4 entries per team, per event. The above limits governing the maximum number of entries per swimmer will still apply. Only the top 2 swimmers, however, can score team points and receive medals.
	• Relays- Schools can enter relay teams without names; however, we would encourage schools to enter individual names when possible for administrative purposes. Designating Relay alternates is not necessary as all swimmers entered in the meet are eligible to compete on a relay. A Relay Entry Card indicating names and order of individual swimmers must be presented to the lane timer by the conclusion of the race.
	• All Events will be pre-seeded and swim slowest to fastest. Swimmers should report directly to the blocks.
	Once entries have been submitted on <u>January 23rd</u> , no substitutions are allowed, only scratches or administrative corrections.
	• A Psych sheet will be sent out by Wednesday January 24 th for confirmation.
AWARDS:	Medals awarded for top 3 places in individual and relay events.
	• Trophies will be awarded to each Team Champion and Individual High Point (Boys and Girls).
SEEDING	All events will be pre-seeded.
RULES	The current VHSL/NFHS Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply. Shaving is forbidden on site. Shaving on site will result in the athlete's removal from further competition.
