	Entries must be submitted in short course yard times only using Hy-Tek Team Manager, 22 events with boys as odd events and girls as even.
	<ul> <li>Meet will be run cardless with the exception of relay entries. Relay entry card must indicate names and order of swimmers not later than the completion of the event. Coaches may enter any eligible swimmers listed on the submitted relay entry submission provided that no swimmer exceeds the 4 allowed entry limitation. Relay cards will be provided.</li> </ul>
	• Times must have been achieved during a meet and after 11/26/18 (Time Trials do not count).
	Swimmers may enter no more than 4 events of which only 2 may be individual events.
	Each team may enter 2 swimmers per individual event (plus up to 2 swimmers with state qualified times).
	Each team may enter 1 relay team per relay event.
	<ul> <li>Any individual that has already met the state qualifying time may be entered in addition to your two regular entries with a maximum of 4 entries per team per event. The above limits governing the maximum number of entries per swimmer will still apply (only the top 2 swimmers score team points).</li> </ul>
	Once entries have been submitted, no substitutions are allowed, only scratches. Relay swimmers can change up until the race as long as the correct swimmers are listed on the card and given to the timer.
AWARDS:	<ul> <li>Medals awarded for top 3 places in individual and relay events.</li> <li>Trophies will be awarded to each Team Champion (Boys and Girls).</li> </ul>
SEEDING	All events will be pre-seeded using entry times
